

Your privacy is critically important to us. At Exprentis we have few fundamental principles:

- We don't ask for your personal information unless we truly need it.
- We don't share your personal information with anyone except to comply with the law, develop our products, or protect our rights.
- Any personal information received from our clients is guarded by a Nondisclosure Agreement and by the information security safeguards imposed by our clients.

Below is our privacy policy which incorporates these goals:

Exprentis, Inc. (“**Exprentis**”) uses personal information data provided by clients in accordance with confidentiality and/or a non disclosure clause included in a master services agreement with a client.

Exprentis operates two websites: www.exprentis.com and www.resolvian.com . It is Exprentis' policy to respect privacy of our website users regarding any information we may collect while operating our website. Our website is for information purpose only and we may collect some information volunteered by our website users.

Website Visitors

Unlike most website operators, Exprentis does not collect non-personally-identifying information of the sort that web browsers and servers typically make available, such as the browser type, language preference, referring site, and the date and time of each visitor request.

Gathering of Personally-Identifying Information

Certain visitors to Exprentis' website choose to interact with Exprentis in ways that require Exprentis to gather personally-identifying information. The amount and type of information that Exprentis gathers depends on the nature of the interaction. For example, we ask visitors who sign up for information at www.exprentis.com or at www.resolvoan.com to provide a username, company name, and email address. In each case, Exprentis collects such information only insofar as is necessary or appropriate to fulfill the purpose of the visitor's interaction with Exprentis. Exprentis does not disclose personally-identifying information other than as described below. The visitors of Exprentis website can always refuse to supply personally-identifying information, with the caveat that it may prevent them from engaging in certain website-related activities.

Protection of Certain Personally-Identifying Information

Exprentis discloses potentially personally-identifying and personally-identifying information only to those of its employees, contractors and affiliated organizations that (i) need to know that information

in order to process it on Exprentis' behalf or to provide services available at Exprentis' websites, and (ii) that have agreed not to disclose it to others. Some of those employees, contractors and affiliated organizations may be located outside of your home country; by using Exprentis' websites, you consent to the transfer of such information to them. Exprentis will not rent or sell potentially personally-identifying and personally-identifying information to anyone other than to its employees, contractors and affiliated organizations, as described above, Exprentis discloses potentially

personally-identifying and personally-identifying information only in response to a subpoena, court order or other governmental request, or when Exprentis believes in good faith that disclosure is reasonably necessary to protect the property or rights of Exprentis, third parties or the public at large. If you are a registered user of an Exprentis website and have supplied your email address, Exprentis may occasionally send you an email to tell you about new features, solicit your feedback, or just keep you up to date with what's going on with Exprentis and our products. We primarily use our various product blogs to communicate this type of information, so we expect to keep this type of email to a minimum. If you send us a request (for example via a support email or via one of our feedback mechanisms), we reserve the right to publish it in order to help us clarify or respond to your request or to help us support other users. Exprentis takes all measures reasonably necessary to protect against the unauthorized access, use, alteration or destruction of potentially personally-identifying and personally-identifying information.

Business Transfers

If Exprentis, or substantially all of its assets were acquired, or in the unlikely event that Exprentis goes out of business or enters bankruptcy, user information would be one of the assets that is transferred or acquired by a third party. You acknowledge that such transfers may occur, and that any acquirer of Exprentis may continue to use your personal information as set forth in this policy.

Privacy Policy Changes

Although most changes are likely to be minor, Exprentis may change its Privacy Policy from time to time, and in Exprentis' sole discretion. Exprentis encourages visitors to frequently check this page for any changes to its Privacy Policy.
